## TUITION & FEES

### TK-12 REGISTRATION FEE

Registration fee is charged once per school year and is non-refundable and non-transferrable.

Returning students are required to submit their application packets for the upcoming school year by April 28<sup>th</sup> to ensure class placement.

### FULL TUITION COST

Tuition cost represents the total cost of educating each student in the respective grades for the entire year/semester. Discounts for pre-payment, family discounts, on-time payment, or worthy student aid are not applicable. Payment for a full year's tuition and any additional fees is required prior to issuance of an I-20 and full acceptance.

### TUITION REFUND

Tuition and fees charged, other than the Registration Fee, are non-refundable unless student visa is denied.

## GENERAL FINANCIAL INFORMATION

### DEPOSIT ACCOUNT

Included in the tuition cost is a \$2,250 deposit to cover extra items not included in the regular cost of tuition and other related fees. This amount is included in the Total Due listed under Tuition Rates. If the entire amount of the deposit account is not used by the end of the school year, the funds may be either refunded or carried over to the following school year at the families discretion and at the approval of LSA. A waiting period of 15 business days is required for all reimbursements. If deposit account funds are depleted and an outstanding balance is incurred it must be paid in full by Zero Balance Day to ensure continued attendance and to sit for final exams.

### ZERO BALANCE DAY

All accounts must be at zero balance by these dates to ensure continued attendance and to sit for final exams.

**Second Semester:** January 15, 2018 (or next business day) is Zero Balance Day for second semester registration clearance.

**End of Year:** May 15, 2018 is Zero Balance Day for end of the year clearance.

### KNIGHT TIME (AFTER SCHOOL CARE)

Students in grades TK-6 who are not picked-up by 3:30 p.m. Monday—Thursday and 1:00 p.m. on Fridays and other minimum days are checked into Extended Care at a rate of \$8 per hour. After School Care is available until 6:00 p.m. Monday—Friday. After 6:00 p.m. the cost is \$30 every 15 minutes. After School Care is billed on a monthly basis to the student's account.

### WORK OPPORTUNITIES

Limited student employment is available on campus for international students 14 years of age and older. International Students must contact the DSO for details and approval. Student job applications and work permit information are available at the International Student Service Office/Business Office.

### RETURNED CHECKS (\$35 fee)

Check payments are accepted for extracurricular activities. If a check or electronic payment is returned for any reason, a fee of \$35.00 is charged. Checks returned for insufficient funds are resubmitted electronically without notifying the drawer. After two incidents of returned items, payments must be made in cashier's check, money order, or debit/credit card. Checks are not accepted for tuition and fees.
