TUITION & FEES

TK-12 APPLICATION FEE

Application fee is charged once per school year and is non-refundable and non-transferrable.

Returning students are required to submit their application packets for the upcoming school year by April 27th to ensure class placement .

FULL TUITION COST

Tuition cost represents the total cost of educating each student in the respective grades for the entire year/semester. Discounts for pre-payment, family discounts, on-time payment, or worthy student aid are not applicable. Payment for a full year's tuition and any additional fees is required prior to issuance of an I-20 and full acceptance.

TUITION REFUND

New Students: Tuition and fees charged are non-refundable after the program start date unless visa is denied.

Returning Students: Tuition and fees charged are non-refundable after the report to school date unless visa renewal is denied.

I-20 PROCESSING FEE

A \$2,000 I-20 processing fee is assessed for new students that withdraw their application before their program start date.

GENERAL FINANCIAL INFORMATION

DEPOSIT ACCOUNT

Included in the tuition cost is a \$2,250 deposit to cover extra curricular items and other related fees not included in the regular cost of tuition . This amount is included in the full tuition cost. If the entire amount is not used by the end of the school year, the funds would either be carried over to the following school year for returning students or reimbursed to non-returning students. A waiting period of 15 business days is required for all reimbursements. If deposit account funds are depleted and an outstanding balance is incurred it must be paid in full by Zero Balance Day to ensure continued attendance and to sit for final exams.

ZERO BALANCE DAY

All accounts must be at zero balance by these dates to ensure continued attendance and to sit for final exams.

SECOND SEMESTER

January 15, 2020 (or next business day) is Zero Balance Day for second semester registration clearance.

END OF YEAR

May 15, 2020 is Zero Balance Day for end of the year clearance.

AFTER SCHOOL CARE

Students in grades TK-6 who are not picked-up by 3:30 p.m. Monday - Thursday and 1:00 p.m. on Fridays and other minimum days are checked in at a rate of \$8 per hour. After School Care is available until 6:00 p.m. Monday - Friday. After 6:00 p.m. the cost is \$30 every 15 minutes. This is billed to the student's tuition account on a monthly basis .

WORK OPPORTUNITIES

Limited student employment is available on campus. Please contact the DSO for details and approval.

RETURNED CHECKS (\$35 FEE)

Check payments are accepted for extracurricular activities. If a check or electronic payment is returned for any reason, a fee of \$35.00 is charged. Checks returned for insufficient funds are resubmitted electronically without notifying the drawer. After two incidents of returned items, payments must be made in cashier's check, money order, or debit/credit card. Checks are not accepted for tuition and fees.
