Domestic Financial Information

GENERAL FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Thank you for joining the LSA family. While tuition is La Sierra Academy's primary source of income, it does not cover the full cost of operating the school. Members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church help support Adventist education through substantial church and conference subsidies.

For your convenience, the annual tuition charge is divided into ten installments billed from August through May. This monthly installment plan is designed to help families spread the cost of tuition over ten months and does not represent the actual cost of education per month.

By submitting an online application and re-enrollment packet, each family agrees to LSA's financial terms and conditions. We ask that every family understand its commitment to the school and faithfully pay tuition and fees on time.

TUITION BILLING & PAYMENT PROCEDURES

Tuition is due on the 10th of each month from August through May. All families are required to set up a FACTS billing plan, which allows parents to access their account at any time to view their tuition payment plan and incidental billing. As a benefit, LSA covers the \$50 FACTS fee for those enrolled in full-year auto-pay.

LATE PAYMENT AND RETURNED CHECK FEES

Any returned payments will incur a \$30 returned payment fee and a \$35 per-family late fee, and may be resubmitted without notification

ZERO BALANCE DAY

All accounts—including tuition and incidentals—must have a zero balance by the following dates to ensure continued attendance, eligibility to sit for final exams, and participation in semester and year-end activities.

- December 10 — First Semester Clearance
- May 10 — Second Semester Clearance

DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS

Accounts must be paid in full by the last day of each month to remain in good standing. Unpaid balances will result in an attendance hold or suspension, meaning students cannot attend classes or participate in school activities. To lift these restrictions, the balance must be paid in full, or a formal payment plan must be approved by Student Finance.

Please note that if a payment plan is defaulted upon, the agreement is voided, and the entire remaining balance becomes due immediately. La Sierra Academy reserves the right to withdraw students if no financial arrangements are in place.

WITHDRAWALS

The first tuition payment is prorated if a student withdraws within the first ten days of attendance. Subsequent tuition installments may be prorated if the student withdraws by the 10th of the month.

EXTENDED CARE (Grades K-8)

Students on campus without adult supervision before or after school will be directed to Extended Care.

Morning Care is provided for students arriving before 7:30 AM (8:45 AM on late-start days).

- Rate: \$5.00 per 30-minute increment.

After School Care is provided for students remaining on campus after dismissal.

- Standard Rate: \$2.50 per 15-minute increment.
- Extended Rate: \$2.50 per minute after 6:00 PM (Monday–Thursday) and after 4:00 PM (Fridays).

TUITION ASSISTANCE

School Financial Aid

La Sierra Academy offers limited financial assistance to qualifying families based on demonstrated need. Please contact the Student Finance Office for an application.

SECC Low Income Assistance Program

The Southeastern California Conference (SECC) provides income-based financial assistance to qualifying Seventh-day Adventist Church members. Contact the Student Finance Office for details.

SECC Ethnic Scholarship

Qualifying churches may apply for assistance for eligible students. Please contact your church pastor or treasurer for further information.

Church Tuition Assistance

Some constituent churches provide tuition assistance to eligible members. Please contact your church pastor or treasurer for further information.

Educational Allowance

The Seventh-day Adventist Church contributes an educational allowance for its eligible employees. This allowance may be applied toward monthly tuition payments if all required documentation is on file in the Student Finance Office before the first installment payment is due.

K–12 PFE Program

LSA students can earn scholarships through the SFFC Foundation's grant program, which allows qualifying students to serve elderly adults in their community.
