La Sierra Academy Office Eligibility Criteria

Criteria for Student Office

Involvement in activities inconsistent with our school mission will exclude candidates from running for office. In addition, once in office, students may be suspended, and a second incident may result in forfeiture of office. Students may also be removed from the office by the administrative committee as a result of disciplinary action, depending on the nature of the activity. If the criteria are not maintained while in office, the student will be placed on probation for one quarter and may be removed at the end of the quarter.

- *Citizenship—The citizenship grade must be a B or better for the current and previous semesters. There must be no suspension, probation, or ongoing behavioral issues during the previous and/or current semester.
Attendance and Community service are a part of the student's citizenship grade.*
- *Cumulative GPA of 2.00 or above with no F's in the current or previous semester.*
- *No incompletes recorded on their transcripts*
- *Residency*- 1 year before the office's term will be held. Must be a full-time student.*

**There are no residency requirements for freshman offices.*

NOTE: Continued eligibility is checked at the end of each quarter or at the discretion of the administrative committee. Student officers who are no longer eligible will be handled according to Article VII, Section 4 of the Student Organization Constitution. "Forfeiture of Office"
