La Sierra Academy Office Eligibility Criteria

Criteria for Student Office

Involvement in activities not consistent with our school mission will exclude candidates from running for office. In addition, once in office, students may be placed on suspension from office, and a second incident may result in forfeiture of office. Students may also be removed from office by the administrative committee as a result of disciplinary action. Depending on the nature of the activity. If the criteria are not maintained while in office, the student will be placed on probation for one quarter and may be removed from the office at the end of the quarter.

- **Citizenship**- No suspension, probation, ongoing behavioral issues during the previous and/or current semester
- **Cumulative GPA** of 2.00**
- **No incompletes recorded on their transcripts**
- **No F's in current classes**- This includes both regular on-campus classes and correspondence courses.

Qualified candidates must meet the above criteria as well as the following prerequisites for running for office:

- **Residency***- 1 year prior to the term in which the office will be held.
- **Attendance**- Acceptable attendance based on attendance policy.
- **Community Service** - Required annual community service hours must be current.

*There are no residency requirements for freshman offices.

**Based on the most recent complete semester prior to application to candidacy. Also included are no Incompletes and no outstanding "F"s in a course required for graduation.

NOTE: Continued eligibility is checked at the end of each quarter or at the discretion of the administrative committee. Student officers who are no longer eligible will be handled according to Article VII, Section 4 of the Student Organization Constitution. "Forfeiture of Office" (2002-2003 Edition)
